The Apache County ACCENT Task Force made 151 drug related arrests in FY 1999, seizing 861 pounds of marijuana, 310 marijuana plants under cultivation, 7 pounds of methamphetamine and 935 dosage units of other drugs. The Apache County Attorney's Office concluded 143 grant related cases during this period, resulting in 124 convictions, of which 21 resulted in prison sentences. The Cochise County Border Alliance Group made 297 drug related arrests in FY 1999, seizing 64,705 pounds of marijuana, 25 marijuana plants under cultivation, 429 grams of methamphetamine and 1,020 dosage units of other drugs. The Cochise County Attorney's Office concluded 537 grant related cases during this period, resulting in 312 convictions, of which 38 resulted in prison sentences. The Cochise County Crime Victim Compensation Board approved payments totaling \$46,549.40. Northern Arizona METRO Street Crimes Task Force made 147 drug related arrests in FY 1999, seizing 32 pounds of marijuana, 61 marijuana plants under cultivation, 5.1 pounds of methamphetamine and 14,315 dosage units of other drugs. 


