



The Apache County ACCENT Task Force made 135 drug related arrests in FY 2000, seizing 318 pounds of marijuana, 984 marijuana plants under cultivation, 23 pounds of methamphetamine and 131 dosage units of other drugs. The Apache County Attorney's Office concluded 179 grant related cases during this period, resulting in 126 convictions, of which 9 resulted in prison sentences. The Apache County Crime Victim Compensation Board approved payments totaling \$37,573. Of the total, the Board approved \$9,681 for funeral costs, \$21,148 for medical expenses, \$4,653 for mental health counseling and \$2,091 for living expenses.



The Cochise County Border Alliance Group made 380 drug related arrests in FY 2000, seizing 636 lbs. of cocaine, 81,638 pounds of marijuana, 243 marijuana plants under cultivation, 1,410 grams of methamphetamine and 75 dosage units of other drugs. The Cochise County Attorney's Office concluded 369 grant related cases during this period, resulting in 229 convictions, of which 35 resulted in prison sentences. The Cochise County Crime Victim Compensation Board approved payments totaling \$68,426. Of the total, the Board approved \$9,261 for funeral costs, \$6,131 for medical expenses, \$9,611 for mental health counseling and \$43,422 for living expenses.

Northern Arizona Street Crimes Task Force (METRO) made 228 drug related arrests in FY 2000, seizing 95 pounds of marijuana, 105 marijuana plants under cultivation, 800 grams of methamphetamine and 12,961 dosage units of other drugs. The Coconino County Attorney's Office concluded 481 grant related cases during this period, resulting in 390 convictions, of which 44 resulted in prison sentences. The Coconino County Crime Victim Compensation Board approved payments totaling \$73,725. Of the total, the Board approved \$34,297 for funeral costs, \$24,522 payments for medical expenses, \$8,443 for mental health counseling and \$6,462 for living expenses.

The Gila County Narcotics Task Force made 274 drug related arrests in FY 2000, seizing 588 pounds of marijuana, 183 marijuana plants under cultivation, 5,177 grams of methamphetamine and 600 units of other drugs. The Gila County Attorney's Office concluded 225 grant related cases during this period, resulting in 218 convictions, of which 23 resulted in prison sentences. The Gila County Crime Victim Compensation Board approved payments totaling \$31,092.
